I recently had the pleasurable experience of working with Robertson Walls & Ceilings on the newly completed Emily Carr University of Art & Design, False Creek Campus.

This Education Center is a 4 storey, 250,000 sq ft purpose built building, all under one roof. The project schedule was a challenge from day 1 and Robertson stepped up to that challenge from the minute they were brought on board. Robertson put a very experienced site team on it, that had been through several fast-paced projects before. The project consisted of Exterior & Interior steel stud systems, plywood sheathing, Insulation, Gypsum Board, T-Bar Ceilings and Acoustical wall panels.
