### UNIQLO RICHMOND



Popular Japanese fashion retailer UNIQLO has opened its third Vancouver-area store at CF Richmond Centre as it expands its operations by opening stores across the country. In the span of just six months, UNIQLO has opened three stores in British Columbia's Lower Mainland, with the area now boasting more stores than Toronto. Robertson Walls & Ceilings worked with Govan Brown to complete this 15,000 sq. ft. project, which included **acoustical ceilings, steel stud framing, and gypsum.**

#### What makes a successful CSO in your opinion?

My opinion of a successful CSO is when you are able to change the safety culture of the organisation. This takes a considerable amount of time and is done through **educating, training, communication, rehearsing,**



and lots of practice.

- When the time and money spent on safety becomes to be regarded as a worthwhile investment rather than an unnecessary bother and expense.
- When the organisation from the management down comes to realize that safety isn't expensive, *it's priceless*.
- When Safe Work Procedures become automatic habits rather than irritating rules.
- When there is a reduction of the workplace injury claims ratio per the number of workers.

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
